ACT OF CONSECRATION TO SAINT JOSEPH

O my beloved Saint Joseph, adopt me as thy child. Take charge of my salvation; watch over me day and night; preserve me from occasions of sin; obtain for me purity of body. Through thy intercession with Jesus, grant me a spirit of sacrifice, humility, self-denial, burning love of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, and a sweet and tender love for Mary, my mother. Saint Joseph, be with me living, be with me dying, and obtain for me a favorable judgment from Jesus, my merciful Savior. Amen.

SPECIAL PRESENTATION: CONSECRATION TO SAINT JOSEPH

- I. Consecrations:
 - A. An Act of Devotion—for a heart eager to worship God and quick to work for God
 - B. Entrusting oneself to a person completely worth of trust:
 - 1. To Jesus—His Eucharistic Sacred Heart
 - 2. To Mary—The Immaculate Heart
 - 3. To Joseph—The Universal Patron of the Church
 - 4. To Our Guardian Angel and All Holy Angels
 - C. Ways of understanding Holy Communion:
 - 1. As Divine—God = Father/Son/Holy Spirit
 - 2. As Heavenly—God/Holy Angels and Saints
 - 3. As Eucharistic:
 - a. Sacramental and Spiritual (received at Holy Mass)
 - b. Spiritual Communion (experienced anywhere by a devoted heart)
 - 4. As The Church:
 - a. Triumphant in Heaven
 - b. Suffering in Purgatory
 - c. Militant on Earth
 - D. Consecration—Entrusting oneself in loving surrender to another through true devotion for greater holiness to make our service a pleasing sacrifice to God
- II. Saint Joseph—A righteous man moved by the Holy Spirit
 - A. Saint Bernardine of Siena:

"Whenever the Divine Favor chooses someone to receive a special grace, or to accept a lofty vocation, God adorns the person chosen with all the gifts of the Spirit needed to fulfill the task at hand.

This general rule is especially verified in the case of Saint Joseph, the foster-father of our Lord and the husband of the Queen of our world, enthroned above the angels. He was chosen by the eternal Father as the trustworthy guardian and protector of his greatest treasures, namely, His divine Son and Mary, Joseph's wife."

- 3. In the Order of Grace: The Guardian and Protector of All the Baptized
 - a. Of the children of Mary by grace
 - b. Of the brothers and sisters of Christ by Baptism
 - c. Of the Christian families that form domestic churches
 - d. In Heaven, God extends, perfects, and brings to completion the work Joseph began on Earth
- C. Joseph = Spiritual Father entrusted to us by the heavenly Father because of:
 - His Righteousness: God's will comes first for Joseph
 - a. His vigilance and silence—humility/prayer
 - b. His heavenly vision—contemplation/angelic dreams
 - c. His earthly work—religious/familial/professional
 - 2. His purity of heart for a:
 - a. Pure soul—intellect and will
 - b. Pure body—mastery of his flesh and emotions
 - c. Life as a living sacrifice of himself to God for those entrusted to him by God

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercy of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice holy, pleasing unto God, your reasonable service" (Romans 12:1).
