# BEAUTY: THE ATTRACTIVE RADIANCE OF GOODNESS AND TRUTH THAT PROVOKES WONDROUS LOVE

- I. Definitions of Beauty by Two Saints:
  - A. St. Thomas Aquinas: "Beauty relates to the cognitive faculty; for beautiful things are those which please on being seen. Hence beauty consists in due proportion" (Summa Theologica, I, 5, 4).

B. St. Francis de Sales: "Union in distinction makes order; order produces agreement; and proportion and agreement, in complete and finished things, make beauty" (*Treatise on the Love of God*, I).

# II. Scripture:

# A. Psalm 27:4

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple.

#### B. Revelation 21:1-3

Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband; and I heard a great voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling of God is with men."

- III. Christ makes His Bride beautiful by the Love (the Holy Spirit) He gives her:
  - A. He dies for her to save her from the ugliness of sin and adorn her with the beauty of grace and the radiance of holiness:
    - 1. Life of grace—the body loses beauty as the soul increases in beauty
    - 2. "Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven" (I Corinthians 15:49).
      - a. On earth—Body comes first, then the immortal soul
      - b. In heaven—First, the perfected soul, then the spiritualized body
    - 3. All angelic and human persons in hell are "ugly as sin."
    - 4. All angelic and human persons in heaven by grace reflect God's beauty.
  - B. God's gift of Love is the Holy Spirit, Whose gifts are manifestations of this Love.
    - 1. Isaiah 11:1-3

There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might [fortitude], the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. And his delight shall be the fear of the Lord.

#### 2. Acts 2:1-4

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one

of them. And they were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

- 3. Sacrament of Confirmation:
  - a. Laying on of Hands:

All-powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit You freed Your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life.

Send Your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide.

Give them the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of right judgment and courage, the Spirit of knowledge and reverence.

Fill them with wonder and awe in Your presence.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

b. Anointing with Chrism:

(Response)—Amen.
Peace be with you.
(Response)—And with your spirit.
