# OVERVIEW: LIFE IN CHRIST—A LIFE OF FEARLESS LOVE IN THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- I. The Original Test of Angels and of Men—Epic Fails (Falls):
  - A. Fall of the Angels (Purely Spiritual, Rational, and Immortal Persons):
    - 1. Satan and His minions ("Non serviam": "I will not serve.")
      - a. "A murderer from the beginning" (John 8:44)
      - b. "A liar and the father of lies" (John 8:44)
    - 2. "And the great dragon was thrown down, the ancient serpent, who is called the Devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him" (Revelation 12:9).
  - B. Fall of Man (Persons with Bodies and Rational, Immortal Souls):
    - 1. Adam—"The whole human race is in Adam" (Catechism #404):
      - a. Eden: "Till and keep."
      - b. "You may freely eat of every tree of the garden but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall die" (Genesis 2:15-17).
      - c. "It is not good that the man should be alone" (Genesis 2:18).
    - 2. Eve—"Woman, because she was taken out of Man" (Genesis 2:23).
      - a. "They become one flesh" (Genesis 2:24).
      - b. "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion . . ." (Genesis 1:28).
    - 3. The Serpent (Satan): "Did God say, 'You shall not eat of any tree of the garden?" (Genesis 3:1).
      - a. Eve and Adam share the forbidden fruit of the tree.
      - b. Our sin tied to—Satan, the forbidden fruit of the tree, and the disobedience of Adam and Eve.
- II. Fallen Creation in the order of nature has been restored by a New Creation in the order of grace:
  - A. Fallen Creation comes through three persons—Satan/Eve/Adam.
  - B. The New Creation comes through three persons—Last Adam/New Eve/Holy Spirit:
    - 1. Jesus—The Last Adam—"Ecce homo"—"Behold, the man" (John 19:5).
    - 2. Mary—the New Eve—"Woman, behold your son" (John 19:25).

- 3. The Holy Spirit—"You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you" (Acts 1:8).
- III. Who Christ gives us to have fearless love as His Bride and Church:
  - 1. His Father and Himself: Baptism ("Our Father")/Eucharist (Wedding Feast of the Lamb).
  - 2. His Mother: "Behold, your mother!" (John 19:27).
  - 3. His Holy Spirit: Pentecost/Baptism/Confirmation.

## SACRED SEVEN QUESTIONS (T/F)

- 1. Death as a punishment for Man is an act of divine justice but not of divine love.
