PRAXIS: BAPTISM AND THE UNIVERSAL CALL TO HOLINESS—SPIRTUAL WARFARE

- I. Fundamental Division: Holiness Versus Sin (The Knowledge of Good and of Evil)
 - A. Personal Relationships: A Child of God or a Slave of Satan
 - 1. God the Father of Truth and Life OR the Father of Lies and Murder
 - 2. The Son (Slain Lamb) of the Father OR the Dragon's Wounded Beast (Anti-Christ)
 - 3. The Holy Spirit OR the Wonder-working Beast (Anti-Holy Spirit)
 - 4. Mary and the Saints (her children) OR the Whore of Babylon and her lovers
 - 5. Michael/Gabriel/Raphael/Guardian Angel OR Satan and his evil minions
 - B. Spiritual Battle in the Soul
 - 1. Memory: Filled with the Truth of the Father OR the Lies of Satan
 - 2. Intellect: Having the Mind of Christ OR the Mind of the Anti-Christ
 - 3. Will: Freedom in the power of the Holy Spirit OR Slavery under the power of the Evil One
 - C. Triple Attack of Evil and the Triple Victory of Grace
 - The World (All about me/Vanity—Power/Fame/Money) CONQUERED BY Prayer (All about God/Humility—Hiddenness/Evangelical Poverty)
 - 2. The Flesh (Lust/Sensuality/Slavery) **OVERCOME BY** Fasting (Chastity/Discipline/Freedom)
 - 3. The Devil (Pride/Taking) **DEFEATED BY** Almsgiving (Loving/Giving)
- II. Perfect Holiness = Complete Separation from Sin through Mercy and Grace
 - A. God = "Holy, Holy, Holy" = Unchanging
 - B. Man = Good AND Evil = Wounded/Lapsed: Called to Healing/Conversion
 - 1. Mind: By the Truth (Right Reason) and the Faith (Revelation)
 - 2. Heart (Will): By good decisions (Virtue)
 - 3. Affections/Emotions: By self-control and submission to Truth/Faith
 - 4. Body (Image—an Icon of God)—By grace and virtue revealing and giving God for others to know and accept Him—"This is My Body, given"
 - a. Reveals God (The Word—Truth and Meaning)—Proclaiming the Gospel
 - b. Offers God (Sacrifice and Service—Self-giving to God and Neighbor)—Love/Evangelization
- III. Baptism: "Full of Grace"
 - A. A holy child chosen by the Heavenly Father and given His Son and Holy Spirit, Mother Mary, and Mother Church
 - B. Another "Christ" as Priest, Prophet, and King
 - 1. Priest—To sacrifice my life to the Father for the benefit of others
 - 2. Prophet—To speak the Truth of right reason and revelation

- 3. King—To conquer sin in myself and in the universe
- C. Living in the freedom of the Holy Spirit on Earth by defending and preparing for my true home awaiting me in Heaven
- D. Re-born to be nourished and strengthened by
 - 1. The Faith (Belief)
 - 2. Worship in Spirit and in Truth (Sacraments)
 - 3. Witness (Evangelization/Apostleship)
 - 4. Prayer
