Qualifications:

- Arrive 20 minutes before Mass.
- Study prayers, parts of the Mass, and items used at Mass.
- Stay after Mass for brief instructions.
- Work as a team with others to help make the Mass run as smoothly as possible.
- Commit to serving on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
