 - A. God: Eternally Good and Happy
 - 1. Creation (visible and invisible) manifests God's goodness
 - —especially in angels and men (rational creatures)
 - 2. Why God created us:
 - a. To manifest His goodness by cooperation in completing His work: pro-creation/fruitful and flourishing dominion
 - b. To come to share His everlasting happiness in heaven
 - B. The Way to Heaven = Jesus (our <u>Life</u>):
 - 1. <u>Truth</u> (The Creed)
 - 2. Freedom (Sacraments/Prayer)
 - 3. <u>Love</u> (Commandments): Obedience to Love for Love
 - a. Choosing what God wants for me in obedience through sacrifice
 - b. Choosing what God wants for others in service
 - C. <u>Knowledge</u> of God Head/Heart/Affections/Body
 - D. <u>Love</u>: Sacrifice that leads to <u>Service</u>
 - 1. We allow God by grace to complete His work in us
 - 2. We complete God's work by:
 - a. Knowing His will
 - b. Doing His will
 - c. Crown of Holy Work = Fruitfulness and Beauty
 - E. Love of God versus Love of Creatures:
 - 1. Self-giving poverty of the Cross versus selfish accumulation of wealth
 - 2. Sacrificing and suffering for the good versus indulging in selfish pleasure
 - 3. Humility in putting God and others before myself versus seeking attention and fame by putting myself over God and others
 - 4. Acknowledging God's power and serving in His Name versus using my own power to make a name for myself
